

SPECS Ewe Ewe Yarns Pattern #131

Designed by Heather Walpole

Measurements: 8-9" high, 17" around Stretches to fit 23-24" head

Yarn: Ewe Ewe Baa Baa Bulky, 132 yards

1 skein (10 Berry)

Needles: US 15 (10 mm) 16" circular knitting needles

Supplies: Stitch marker, darning needle Gauge: 8 sts to 4" in stockinette stitch

notes The yarn is held double throughout the hat by being pulled from the outside and inside of the skein. This hat uses the

entire ball for an adult size hat.

begin With yarn held doubled, cast on 42 stitches, place marker and join in the round being careful not to twist cast-on

stitches.

work rib Round 1: *K1, P1, rep from * around.

Repeat Row 1 for 9 rounds more.

hat Round 11: Knit around.

Continue to work as for Round 11 until hat measures 8-9" from the beginning or until there is about 1½ yards of yarn left.

Bind off.

Pull the remaining yarn through the last stitch, lay the hat flat and sew a seam across the top to close the hat. This will

finish form the finished kitty cat ears.
