

RYN YARN



Amherst Triangle Scarf

Who can resist draping on a generous easy to wear asymmetrical scarf perfect for summer or winter? Enjoy this fun fast knit that shows off the beauty of these two unique yarns with a alternating garter/stockinette stitch.

MATERIALS

Yarns:

Brown Scarf -

- 1 Skein Kauni Effektgarn (photo shows color ED)
- 1 Skein the LOOM Fusilli-80 (photo shows color 9)

Red, White & Blue Scarf -

- 1 Skein Kauni Effektgarn (front photo shows color EMS)
- 1 Skein the LOOM Risoni (front photo shows color 13)

Needle size:

US #5 circular needles, at least 24-inch length or needle to achieve gauge listed below [always use a needle size that gives you the gauge listed to the right -- every knitter's gauge is unique]

Notions:

Yarn needle for weaving in ends

Standard Kauni row set:

Row 1: SI 1st st pwise, K to last st, p last st.

Row 2: SI 1st st pwise, k to last sts, p last st.

Increase Fusilli-80 or Risoni row set:

Row 1: SI 1st st pwise, kfb, k until 2 sts left on needle, kfb, p last st. (2 sts increased in row)

Row 2: SI 1st st pwise, p across row.

Standard Fusilli-80 or Risoni row set:

Row 1: SI 1st st pwise, k until 1 st left on needle, p last st.

Row 2: SI 1st st pwise, p across row.

SET UP

Row 1: With Kauni cast on 12 sts and k to last st, p last st

Row 2: SI 1st st pwise, k to last sts, p last st.

Then starting with Fusilli-80, work rows 1 and 2 of increase Fusilli-80 or Risoni row set. After row 2 of increase Fusilli-80 or Risoni set, work the pattern as follows:

PATTERN

*K standard Kauni set, standard Fusilli-80 or Risoni set, standard Kauni set, standard Fusilli-80 or Risoni set, standard Kauni set, then increase Fusilli-80 or Risoni set. * Repeat from *

Continue in this manner alternating standard Kauni and Fusilli-80 or Risoni set increasing every 6th row set using one Fusilli-80 or Risoni increasing row set until you have 80 total sts on the needle or continue on to make a larger, more luxurious scarf if you wish. At desired completion, break Fusilli-80 or Risoni and work 1 more standard row set with Kauni, then bind off loosely with Kauni as follows.

K2, *transfer the 2 worked sts to the lh needle and k2tog tbl, k1* repeat from * until all sts are bound off. Block to desired dimensions and make another one :-)

GAUGE

16 sts/30 rows = 4 inches in stockinette (blocked) SIZE: one size 3"x 28" x 66"Triangle (after blocking)

ABBREVIATIONS

k: knit

p: purl

pwise: purlwise

sts: stitches

sl: slip

K2tog tbl: knit 2 stitch together thru the back loop
