



Easy Ombre Headband Knitting Pattern

You will need:

- 1 ball [Schoppel-Wolle Reggae Ombre Yarn](#), shown in #2249
- [Size US 9 knitting needles](#)
- [Cable needle](#)
- [Tapestry needle](#)

Measures: 2.75" wide x 20" circumference

Gauge: 5 sts per inch over stitch pattern

Headband Pattern

Cast on 14 stitches

Note: More advanced knitters may want to use a provisional cast on and join ends with Kitchener stitch.

Row 1: SI1, knit across row

Row 2: SI1, k3, p6, k4

Row 3: SI1, knit across row

Row 4: SI1, k3, p6, k4

Row 5: SI1, k3, sl 3 stitch onto cable needle and place in front. Knit next 3 sts. Knit the 3 sts from cable needle. K4

Row 6: SI1, k3, p6, k4

Row 7: SI1, k across row

Row 8: SI1, k3, p6, k4

Row 9: SI1, k across row

Row 10: SI1, k3, p6, k4

Row 11: SI1, k across row

Row 12: SI1, k3, p6, k4

Row 13: SI1, k across row

Row 14: SI1, k3, p6, k4





Row 15: Sl1, k3, sl 3 stitch onto cable needle and place in front. Knit next 3 sts. Knit the 3 sts from cable needle. K4

Repeat Rows 6-15 until panel measures approx. 19" from the beginning.

Work last 4 rows as follows.

Row 1: Sl1, k3, p6, k4

Row 2: Sl1, k across row

Row 3: Sl1, k3, p6, k4

Row 4: Sl1, k across row

Bind off in established pattern. Seam ends together and wear!

Abbreviations

K: knit

K2tog: knit two stitches together (decrease)

P purl

Sl 1 slip 1 stitch (as if to knit)

St(s) stitch(es)
