



Katy Scarf Knitting Pattern

This pretty scarf is worked back and forth from one end to the other and features a soft curve. Then, stitches are picked up and worked in garter stitch to create the ruffle.

You will need:

- 1 hank <u>Fiesta Katy Yarn</u>, shown in Cornucopia
- Size US 7 straight needles
- Size US 6 circular 32" or longer needles
- Tapestry needle

Measures: 64" long x 9.5" wide at center, not including ruffle

Gauge: 20 sts to 4" in stockinette stitch on larger needles

Scarf - First Half

Using size 7 needle, cast on 4 sts Row 1 (RS): K2, kfb, k1. (5 sts total) Row 2 and all even rows (WS): SI1, p to last 3 sts. k3.

Row 3: K

Row 5: K to last 2 sts, kfb, k1. (6 sts total)

Row 7: K

Row 9: K to last 2 sts, kfb, k1. (7 sts total)



To shape first half of shawl, continue working in established pattern, increasing every 4th row until there are 52 sts on the needle. Work even for 5 rows. Now you will begin shaping the second half of the scarf.

Scarf - Second Half

Row 1: K to last 3 sts, k2tog, k1. (51 sts total)

Row 3: K

Row 5: K to last 3 sts, k2tog, k1. (50 sts total)





Row 7: K

Row 9: K to last 3 sts, k2tog, k1. (49 sts total)

Continue working in established pattern, decreasing every 4th row until only 4 sts remain on the needle. Work 1 more row and then bind off.

Ruffle

Use size 6 needle. With RS facing, pick up 200 sts evenly along curved edge of scarf.

Row 1: K

Row 2: Kfb in every st - to 400 sts on needle.

Row 3: K

Row 4: Kfb in every st - to 800 sts on needle.

Row 5: K

Row 6: K

Row 7: K

Row 8: K

Bind off.

Weave in yarn ends and block lightly.

Abbreviations

K knit

K2tog: knit two stitches together (decrease)

KFB knit front and back (increase)

P purl

RS right side St(s) stitch(es) WS wrong side Yo yarn over
