



MANOS DEL URUGUAY

Dentado Scarf

SIZE

70" x 11"

MATERIALS

Manos del Uruguay CLARA (100% superwash merino, approx. 100g/385 yds), 1 sk each colors A and B. Shown in C22 Petroleo(A) and C10 Azafran(B).

US 7/4.5mm needle or size to obtain gauge

GAUGE

20 sts and 30 rows = 4" over Stockinette Stitch

NOTE

Color C22 Petroleo often discharges quite a bit of excess dye in the first washing. If you're using it and intend to wash the finished scarf, we recommend washing the skein before knitting, as follows: Tie the yarn in 2-3 additional places with waste yarn. Rinse in several changes of cool water, until water runs clear. Drain, then gently squeeze out excess water. Allow to dry flat. Wind and proceed with your scarf!



ABBREVIATIONS

k: knit
 k2tog: knit 2 stitches together
 m1L: insert tip of left ndl, from front to back, under running thread between last st and next st; k into back of loop
 m1R: insert tip of left ndl, from back to front, under running thread between last st and next st; k into front of loop
 ndl(s): needle(s)
 p: purl
 rep: repeat
 RS: right side
 ssk: slip 2 sts, one at a time, as if to knit; return sts to left ndl in turned position, then k tog tbl
 st(s): stitch(es)
 tbl: through back of loop
 WS: wrong side

INSTRUCTIONS

Using color A, cast on 72 sts. Knit 1 row.

Border

Row 1 (RS): Slip 1 purlwise with yarn in front, *k2tog, k4, m1L, k1, m1R, k12, ssk; rep from * twice more, k2tog, k4, m1L, k1, k1tbl.

Row 2: Slip 1 purlwise with yarn in front, k to last st, k1tbl.

Work rows 1 and 2 3 times more.

Body

Row 1 (RS): Slip 1 purlwise with yarn in front, *k2tog, k4, m1L, k1, m1R, k12, ssk; rep from * twice more, k2tog, k4, m1L, k1, k1tbl.

Row 2: Slip 1 purlwise with yarn in front, k7, p to last 8 sts, k7, k1tbl.

Rep rows 1 and 2 of Body until scarf measures 35", working two-row stripes of color B at random intervals. (Carry unused yarn up the side of the work, catching it under working yarn every other row.)

At 35", switch colors so that B is now the main color, and work occasional stripes of A.

Work until piece measures 69", ending having just worked a WS row.

Border

Work rows 1 and 2 of Border four times, then bind off knitwise.

Finishing

Weave in ends. Steam-block to shape.
