



The Ribby  
Slouch Hat

**Materials:**

1 skein of either Knit Collage Swirl or Daisy Chain yarn (approx 60 yds of yarn per skein)  
Needles: 16" US size 15 circulars  
Darning needle for weaving ends  
Stitch marker

**Finished Measurements:**

Approximately 10" long x 7" wide at brim opening

**Gauge:**

Approximately 2 stitches per inch in the stitch of the pattern (given below!).

**Abbreviations:**

Ktbl = knit through back loop. Insert needle purl wise through back of stitch, wrap yarn and pull through.  
K2tbl = knit two together through back loop  
p= purl

**Pattern:**

CO 40 with Old Norwegian method\*\* (or a similarly stretchy method of your choice), place marker and join to knit in the round.

All rounds: [Ktbl,p] around.

Continue till only 2 yards of yarn remain or until your hat is your desired length.

Last row: K2tbl around (20 stitches)

Weave yarn through remaining stitches and cinch tight.

Weave in ends, and block so that ribs are visible and hat is slouchy and loose.
